"AN ACT PROHIBITING LIBRARIES FROM AGREEING TO CERTAIN TERMS IN ELECTRONIC BOOK AND DIGITAL AUDIOBOOK LICENSE AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
 following in lieu thereof:

"Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
to study methods to address the costs charged for libraries in this state
to obtain digital audiobooks and electronic books and potential
solutions to minimize such costs.

8 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,9 who is a representative of a library;
