"AN ACT PROHIBITING LIBRARIES FROM AGREEING TO CERTAIN TERMS IN ELECTRONIC BOOK AND DIGITAL AUDIOBOOK LICENSE AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) No library shall distribute any electronic book containing pornographic material. As used in this 4 5 section, "pornographic material" means any work (1) depicting sexual 6 activity or nudity in a manner intended to cause sexual arousal or 7 excitement, and (2) when taken as a whole, appeals to the prurient 8 interest and lacks any serious literary, artistic, political or scientific value 9 and "library" and "electronic book" have the same meanings as provided in section 1 of this act." 10

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
