"AN ACT REQUIRING THE LICENSURE OF LACTATION CONSULTANTS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the 2 following in lieu thereof:

"Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2026*) As used in this section and
section 2 of this act:

5 (1) "Lactation consultant" means a person who holds and maintains 6 certification in good standing as an international board lactation 7 consultant with the International Board of Lactation Consultant 8 Examiners; and

9 (2) "Lactation consulting" means a clinical application of scientific 10 principles and a multidisciplinary body of evidence for evaluation, 11 problem identification, treatment, education and consultation to 12 families regarding the course of lactation and feeding, including, but not 13 limited to, the following services:

14	(A) Taking maternal, child and feeding histories;		
15	(B) Performing clinical assessments related to breastfeeding and

25	referring to other health care practitioners, as necessary;		
26	(G) Conducting appropriate follow-up appointments and evaluating		
27	outcomes; and		
28	(H) Documenting patient encounters in a patient record.		
29	Sec. 2. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2026) (a) The commissioner shall (1)		
30	conduct an ongoing review of lactation consultant education and		
31	training programs, (2) provide a list of approved lactation consultant		
32	education and training programs, which shall include training in core		
33	lactation consultant competencies, and (3) recommend lactation		
34	consultant continuing education requirements to the commissioner.		
35	(b) (1) On and after October 1, 2025, no person shall use the title		
36	"lactation consultant" or the designation "IBCLC" or "L.C." unless such		
37	person is certified pursuant to this section.		
38	(2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who (A)		
39	is licensed by the Department of Public Health pursuant to title 20 of the		
40	general statutes or by the Department of Consumer Protection pursuant		
41	to chapter 400j of the general statutes and providing lactation consulting

42 while acting within the scope of practice of the person's license or 43 certification, provided the person does not refer to himself or herself by 44 the term "lactation consultant", (B) is a student enrolled in a lactation 45 consulting educational program or an accredited education program the 46 completion of which is required for licensure or certification by the 47 Department of Public Health pursuant to title 20 of the general statutes 48 or by the Department of Consumer Protection pursuant to chapter 400j 49 of the general statutes, lactation consulting is a part of the student's 50 course of study and the student is performing such consulting under 51 appropriate program supervision, provided the student does not refer 52 to himself or herself by the term "lactation consultant", (C) provides 53 lactation education and support through the federal Special 54 Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children, 55 administered pursuant to section 19a-59c of the general statutes, or any 56 other federally funded nutrition assistance program administered in the 57 state, to participants in such program while acting within the person's 58 job description and training, provided the person does not refer to himself or herself by the term "lactation consultant", (D) is a community 59 60 health worker, as defined in section 20-195ttt of the general statutes, and 61 providing lactation support to a HUSKY Health program member, 62 provided the community health worker does not refer to himself or 63 herself by the term "lactation consultant", (E) provides education, social 64 support, peer support, peer counseling or nonclinical services relating 65 to lactation and feeding, provided the person does not refer to himself 66 or herself by the term "lactation consultant", (F) is a doula or midwife 67 and providing services within the doula's or midwife's scope of practice 68 and for which the doula or midwife is trained, provided the doula or 69 midwife does not refer to himself or herself by the term "lactation 70 consultant", or (G) is a public health professional and engaging in 71 outreach, engagement, education, coaching, informal counseling, social 72 support, advocacy, care coordination or research related to social 73 determinants of health or a basic screening or assessment of any risk 74 associated with social determinants of health, provided the professional 75 does not refer to himself or herself by the term "lactation consultant".

76 (c) Each person seeking certification to practice as a lactation 77 consultant shall apply to the Department of Public Health, on forms 78 prescribed by the commissioner. Such application shall include: (1) 79 Proof that the applicant is eighteen years of age or older; (2) two 80 reference letters from families or professionals with direct knowledge of 81 the applicant's experience as a lactation consultant verifying the 82 applicant's training or experience; and (3) a demonstration of the 83 applicant's completion of a lactation training program or a combination 84 of such programs approved pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.

(d) The commissioner shall adopt continuing education requirements
for lactation consultants provided by the commissioner pursuant to
subsection (a) of this section.

(e) Certification issued under this section may be renewed every
three years. The certification shall be renewed in accordance with the
provisions for renewal under section 19a-88 of the general statutes. Each
lactation consultant applying for renewal shall provide to the
commissioner evidence of completion of the continuing education
requirements adopted pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.

94 (f) The commissioner may take any disciplinary action set forth in 95 section 19a-17 of the general statutes against a lactation consultant for 96 failure to conform to the accepted standards of the profession, 97 including, but not limited to, any of the following reasons: (1) Fraud or 98 deceit in obtaining or seeking reinstatement of a certification to practice 99 as a lactation consultant; (2) engaging in fraud or material deception in 100 the course of professional services or activities; (3) negligent, 101 incompetent or wrongful conduct in professional activities; (4) aiding or 102 abetting the use of the title "lactation consultant" by an individual who 103 is not certified pursuant to this section; (5) physical, mental or emotional 104 illness or disorder resulting in an inability to conform to the accepted 105 standards of the profession; or (6) abuse or excessive use of drugs, 106 including alcohol, narcotics or chemicals."
