- person may serve until a successor is appointed and confirmed in
- 8 accordance with this section [. Such person] and may be reappointed for
- 9 succeeding terms."

13 "Sec. 7. (NEW) (Effective January 1, 2026) The Office of the Correction

14 Ombuds, established pursuant to section 18-81qq of the general statutes,

as amended by this act, in consultation with the office of the Attorney

16 General, shall publish on said offices' Internet web sites a list of the case

17 captions and the names of the parties for each case filed on or after

18 January 1, 2026, against the Department of Correction relating to

19 excessive use of force or medical neglect that is defended by the

20 Attorney General."
