## "AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE AND PATIENT PROTECTION."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
 following in lieu thereof:

"Section 1. Section 38a-1085 of the general statutes is amended by
adding subsection (d) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of title 38a, for the open 6 enrollment periods beginning on November 1, 2025, and November 1, 7 2026, the exchange shall, in consultation with the Department of Social 8 Services, implement an enhanced direct enrollment process in 9 accordance with applicable rules and regulations adopted by the federal 10 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for any qualified health 11 plan issuer or web broker licensed in this state to directly enroll any 12 prospective enrollee in a qualified health benefit plan through the

- 17 a qualified health benefit plan through the exchange."

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This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

Section 1	from passage	38a-1085(d)
