"AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE AND PATIENT PROTECTION."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 38a-1085 of the general statutes is amended by
4 adding subsection (d) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of title 38a, for the open
6 enrollment periods beginning on November 1, 2025, and November 1,
7 2026, the exchange shall, in consultation with the Department of Social
8 Services, implement an enhanced direct enrollment process in
9 accordance with applicable rules and regulations adopted by the federal
10 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for any qualified health
11 plan issuer or web broker licensed in this state to directly enroll any
12 prospective enrollee in a qualified health benefit plan through the

13 exchange. For purposes of this subsection, "enhanced direct enrollment"
14 means a service that allows any qualified health plan issuer or web
15 broker licensed in this state to access the exchange platform on behalf of
16 any prospective enrollee to directly enroll such prospective enrollee in
17 a qualified health benefit plan through the exchange."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
