## "AN ACT CONCERNING SUNDAY HUNTING ON PRIVATE LANDS OF TEN ACRES OR MORE."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Department of Energy 4 and Environmental Protection shall not implement a bear hunt in this 5 state until said agency creates, implements and evaluates the effectiveness of a comprehensive bear management plan. Such plan 6 7 shall focus on avoiding human-to-bear interactions and mitigating bear 8 habituation. Additionally, such plan shall consist of preventative 9 measures, including, but not limited to, banning wildlife feeders in high 10 contact areas, mandatory use of bear resistant trashcans in high contact 11 areas, public education campaigns and the institution of protective 12 measures for livestock and crops."
