"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BLACK BEAR POPULATION IN THE STATE."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Section. 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Energy 3 and Environmental Protection shall not implement a bear hunt in this 4 state until said agency creates, implements and evaluates the 5 effectiveness of a comprehensive bear management plan. Such plan 6 shall focus on avoiding human-to-bear interactions and mitigating bear 7 habituation. Additionally, such plan shall consist of preventative 8 measures, including, but not limited to, banning wildlife feeders in high 9 contact areas, mandatory use of bear resistant trashcans in high contact 10 areas, public education campaigns and the institution of protective 11 measures for livestock and crops."
