**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFICE OF THE CORRECTION OMBUDS, DISCLOSURE OF DISCIPLINARY MATTERS OR ALLEGED MISCONDUCT BY A DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION EMPLOYEE AND USE OF FORCE AND BODY CAMERAS IN CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (k) of section 18-81jj of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5 *passage*):

6 (k) Not later than eighty days after May 10, 2022, or not later than  
7 sixty days after any vacancy in the position of Correction Ombuds, the  
8 Correction Advisory Committee shall solicit applications for such  
9 position and meet to consider and interview the most qualified  
10 candidates who are residents of this state and attorneys-at-law who  
11 shall have been admitted to practice before the courts of the state of

12 Connecticut for such position. Said committee shall select not fewer than  
13 three and not more than five of the most outstanding candidates,  
14 publish the names of such selected candidates on said committee's  
15 Internet web site and hold a public hearing allowing testimony from  
16 members of the public concerning the selected candidates. Said  
17 committee shall submit to the Governor a list of selected candidates.  
18 Such list shall rank the candidates in the order of committee preference."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
