"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF REPRODUCTIVE AND GENDER-AFFIRMING HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO PATIENTS."

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) On and after July 1, 2025, no
- 4 licensed health care provider who has prescriptive authority in this state
- 5 may prescribe any puberty-blocking medication or provide artificial
- 6 cross sex hormone medication or treatment to any person under the age
- 7 of eighteen for any use that has not been approved by the federal Food
- 8 and Drug Administration, including any medication or treatment
- 9 relating to gender-affirming health care services, as defined in section
- 10 52-571m of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

sHB 7135 Amendment

Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) On and after July 1, 2025, no person licensed to practice medicine and surgery pursuant to chapter 370 of the general statutes may practice surgery on a person under the age of eighteen for the purpose of sex reassignment or for the provision of gender-affirming health care services, as defined in section 52-571m of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
