**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF REPRODUCTIVE
AND GENDER-AFFIRMING HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO
PATIENTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) On and after July 1, 2025, no
4 licensed health care provider who has prescriptive authority in this state
5 may prescribe any puberty-blocking medication or provide artificial
6 cross sex hormone medication or treatment to any person under the age
7 of eighteen for any use that has not been approved by the federal Food
8 and Drug Administration, including any medication or treatment
9 relating to gender-affirming health care services, as defined in section
10 52-571m of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

11 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) On and after July 1, 2025, no
12 person licensed to practice medicine and surgery pursuant to chapter
13 370 of the general statutes may practice surgery on a person under the
14 age of eighteen for the purpose of sex reassignment or for the provision
15 of gender-affirming health care services, as defined in section 52-571m
16 of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
