1 Delete lines 76 to 87, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the 2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) If a court determines by clear and convincing evidence that a
4 firearm industry member has violated any provision of section 2 of this
5 act, the court may award any or all of the following:

6 (1) Injunctive relief sufficient to prevent the firearm industry member7 and any other defendant from further violating the law.

- 8 (2) Compensatory damages.
- 9 (3) Punitive damages.
- 10 (4) Restitution.
- 11 (5) Costs and reasonable attorney's fees.
