"AN ACT INCREASING RESOURCES FOR STUDENTS, SCHOOLS AND SPECIAL EDUCATION."

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and

- 3 "Sec. 501. Section 10-212k of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):
- 5 [On and after September 1, 2024] For the school year commencing
- 6 July 1, 2025, and each school year thereafter, each local and regional
- 7 board of education shall provide free menstrual products, as defined in
- 8 section 18-69e, in women's restrooms [,] and all-gender restrooms, [and
- 9 at least one men's restroom, which restrooms are accessible to students
- in grades three to twelve, inclusive, in each school under the jurisdiction
- of such boards and in a manner that does not stigmatize any student
- 12 seeking such products, pursuant to guidelines established by the
- 13 Commissioner of Public Health under section 19a-131*l*. To carry out the

14 provisions of this section, the local and regional boards of education

- may (1) accept donations of menstrual products and grants from any
- source for the purpose of purchasing such products, and (2) partner
