***"AN ACT INCREASING RESOURCES FOR STUDENTS, SCHOOLS
AND SPECIAL EDUCATION."***

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 10-212k of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):

5 [On and after September 1, 2024] For the school year commencing
6 July 1, 2025, and each school year thereafter, each local and regional
7 board of education shall provide free menstrual products, as defined in
8 section 18-69e, in women's restrooms [,] and all-gender restrooms, [and
9 at least one men's restroom,] which restrooms are accessible to students
10 in grades three to twelve, inclusive, in each school under the jurisdiction
11 of such boards and in a manner that does not stigmatize any student
12 seeking such products, pursuant to guidelines established by the
13 Commissioner of Public Health under section 19a-131l. To carry out the

14 provisions of this section, the local and regional boards of education
15 may (1) accept donations of menstrual products and grants from any
16 source for the purpose of purchasing such products, and (2) partner
17 with a nonprofit or community-based organization."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
