## "AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF QUOTAS BY WAREHOUSE DISTRIBUTION CENTERS."

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
- 2 following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) There is established a task force
- 4 to study the use of quotas by warehouse distribution centers in the state.
- 5 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 6 (1) The chairpersons and ranking members of the joint standing
- 7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 8 relating to labor and public employees, or their designees;
- 9 (2) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 10 (3) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- 11 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
- 12 Representatives;

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- 13 (5) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 14 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of 15 Representatives;
- 16 (7) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 17 (8) The Labor Commissioner, or the commissioner's designee; and
- 18 (9) The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development.
- 19 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
- 20 (2), (3), (4), (5), (6) or (7) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
- 21 of the General Assembly.
- 22 (d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later
- 23 than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall
- 24 be filled by the appointing authority.
- 25 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro
- 26 tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force from
- among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall schedule
- 28 the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty
- 29 days after the effective date of this section.
- 30 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
- 31 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor and
- 32 public employees shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.
- 33 (g) Not later than January 1, 2026, the task force shall submit a report
- on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of
- 35 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor
- 36 and public employees, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
- 4a of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that
- 38 it submits such report or January 1, 2026, whichever is later."
