**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM  
ENDING JUNE 30, 2027, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS  
THEREFOR, AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO REVENUE AND  
OTHER ITEMS IMPLEMENTING THE STATE BUDGET."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (h) of section 31-53 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*  
5 *2025*):

6 (h) (1) The provisions of this section shall not apply where (A) the  
7 combined total cost or total bond authorization for all work to be  
8 performed by all contractors and subcontractors in connection with new  
9 construction of any public works project is less than one million dollars,  
10 or (B) the combined total cost of all work to be performed by all

11 contractors and subcontractors in connection with any remodeling,  
12 refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any  
13 public works project is less than one hundred thousand dollars. For  
14 purposes of this subdivision, no private funds of any kind made  
15 towards the new construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing,  
16 rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project shall be  
17 included in the calculation of the combined total cost of such new  
18 construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation,  
19 alteration or repair of any public works project.

20 (2) On and after October 31, 2017, and prior to July 1, 2019, the  
21 provisions of this subdivision shall not apply where the work to be  
22 performed by any contractor or subcontractor in connection with new  
23 construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation,  
24 alteration or repair of any public works project funded in whole or in  
25 part by any private bequest that is greater than nine million dollars but  
26 less than twelve million dollars for a municipality in New Haven  
27 County with a population of not less than twelve thousand and not  
28 more than thirteen thousand, as determined by the most recent  
29 population estimate by the Department of Public Health.

30 (3) On and after July 1, 2019, and prior to January 1, 2020, the  
31 provisions of this subdivision shall not apply where the work to be  
32 performed by any contractor or subcontractor in connection with new  
33 construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation,  
34 alteration or repair of any public works project funded in whole or in  
35 part by any private bequest that is greater than nine million dollars but  
36 less than twenty-two million dollars for a municipality in New Haven  
37 County with a population of not less than twelve thousand and not  
38 more than thirteen thousand, as determined by the most recent  
39 population estimate by the Department of Public Health."
