"AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY AFFORDABILITY, ACCESS AND ACCOUNTABILITY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 22a-20b of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, any special
6 act, municipal charter or ordinance, in any municipality having a
7 population of [ten] sixteen thousand persons or fewer, any elector or
8 voter of such municipality may petition for a town referendum, in
9 accordance with the applicable provisions of sections 7-7 and 7-9, for the
10 reversal of any approval or denial, as applicable, of a permit by the
11 Connecticut Siting Council or the commissioner pursuant to section 22a-
12 20a, that is based on the considerations required by subsection (g) of
13 said section. An affirmative vote of such electorate shall constitute the

- 14 reversal of any such approval or denial, as applicable, of such permit
15 notwithstanding such approval or denial by the Connecticut Siting
16 Council or the commissioner, as applicable."
