"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2027, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO REVENUE AND OTHER ITEMS IMPLEMENTING THE STATE BUDGET."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Secretary of the State shall not use the name, image or likeness of any candidate for public office or any elected public official, including the Secretary, in any public awareness campaign developed and conducted by the Secretary of the State, for purposes of educating the public on matters relating to elections or voting, during the ninety-day period immediately prior to a primary or election.
- (b) The Secretary of the State shall be subject to a maximum penalty
 of ten thousand dollars for each violation of the provisions of subsection
 (a) of this section, the payment of which the Secretary shall be personally
