## "AN ACT CONCERNING VARIOUS REFORMS TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF ELECTIONS IN THIS STATE."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) There is established a
- 4 bipartisan Senate Committee on Contested Elections, consisting of two
- 5 members of the Senate appointed by the majority leader of the Senate
- 6 and two members of the Senate appointed by the minority leader of the
- 7 Senate, which committee shall be convened whenever a candidate for
- 8 the Senate contests the results of an election for such candidate's district.
- 9 Such committee shall take testimony and issue a formal and final
- 10 decision on such election contest in accordance with the provisions of
- section 7 of article third of the Constitution of the state. Until the
- 12 issuance of such final decision by such committee, the Secretary of the
- 13 State shall not certify the results of such election."

sHB 7228 Amendment

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 501 *from passage* New section
