AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT

SUMMARY: Existing law generally requires the Workers' Compensation Commission's chairperson to annually (1) set a fee schedule for workers' compensation medical providers who provide medical services under the Workers' Compensation Act and (2) update relative values based on the Medicare resourcebased relative value scale (RBRVS), which ranks medical services by the relative cost of resources needed to produce them.

By law, the chairperson was required to convert to a fee schedule using the RBRVS as the basis for workers' compensation practitioner fees in 2008, and the conversion had to be revenue-neutral. This act removes the requirement that the conversion be revenue-neutral, clarifying that this requirement does not apply to the annual RBRVS-based fee schedule updates. EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2025

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
