
OLR Bill Analysis

HB 5295 (as amended by House "A")*

AN ACT NAMING THE CONNECTICUT NATIONAL GUARD READINESS CENTER IN THE TOWN OF PUTNAM.

SUMMARY

This bill names the Connecticut National Guard readiness center in Putnam the "John N. Dempsey Putnam National Guard Readiness Center." John N. Dempsey was the 81st governor and captain-general of Connecticut and served as both mayor of and state representative for Putnam.

The bill also repeals sHB 5406, § 17, as amended by House "A," and passed by the House, which has a substantially similar provision naming the readiness center.

*House Amendment "A" renames the Connecticut National Guard Readiness Center in Putnam and adds the repealer.

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 1, 2026
