The Committee on Banking reported through REP. DOUCETTE of the 13th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY CONCERNING FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Banking shall
2 conduct a study concerning financial transactions in the state. Not later
3 than January 15, 2027, the department shall submit a report, in
4 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
5 concerning the results of such study to the joint standing committee of
6 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to banking.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
