### ***Explanation***

The bill requires any state agency that contracts for consultant services that (1) are valued at least \$100,000 and (2) provide recommendations to submit a report to the legislative Government Oversight Committee regarding implementation of the recommendations, resulting in a potential cost to various state agencies beginning in FY 27.

There is a potential cost to various state agencies<sup>1</sup> beginning in FY 27, to the extent that additional administrative burden will be created for agencies that rely heavily on contracting, and a potential additional cost to the extent that current contracts impacted by the bill would need to be amended.

### ***The Out Years***

<sup>1</sup> Potentially impacted agencies include the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), State Department of Education (DOE), Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD), Office of Early Childhood (OEC), Office of Policy and Management (OPM), and Department of Social Services (DSS), among others.
