Explanation

The bill, which requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) in consultation with the Department of Consumer Protection (DCP), to conduct a feasibility study on end-of-life management of materials for e-cigarettes and vapes, does not result in a fiscal impact as the departments have the staff and expertise necessary to complete the study. Additionally, the bill makes procedural and clarifying changes to the architectural paint extended producer responsibility program, which has no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
