Explanation

The bill may result in increased costs to the state and municipalities to the extent the standard protocols required under the bill lead to more extreme weather activations than under current practice. For context costs associated with increased activations may include, but are not limited to, municipalities opening more cooling or warming centers, the Department of Social Services supporting additional rides for members via non-emergency medical transportation, and the Department of Housing supporting hoteling.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the increase in extreme weather activations.
