AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISPLAY OF LIGHTED LAMPS ON BICYCLES, ELECTRIC BICYCLES AND ELECTRIC SCOOTERS.

Explanation

The bill, which requires certain small vehicles to display a lighted lamp when operating on public highways at certain times, results in a minimal potential revenue gain to the extent new offenses are committed and fines are collected.¹

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of offenses and fines collected.

¹ Between FY 22 and FY 25, 17 offenses were recorded under CGS § 14-288 and \$368 in fines was collected.
