CORRECTION

To Fiscal Note on LCO No. 4137
SB-381, File No. 158

AN ACT REQUIRING PROGRAMS CONCERNING PROBLEM
GAMBLING AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

The fiscal note on the amendment incorrectly stated that the amendment made the problem gambling program established by the underlying bill optional, and stated that the fiscal impact noted in the underlying bill would only occur if a constituent unit of higher education chose to conduct an online gambling program.

The fiscal note on the amendment should have stated that the amendment has no fiscal impact. It makes optional the underlying bill's requirement for the constituent units to prioritize contracting with certain nonprofits to conduct the program, if a constituent unit chooses to engage a nonprofit. The amendment does not change the requirement for the constituent units to conduct the program, and therefore does not change the fiscal impact of the underlying bill.
