***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION
FOR CERTAIN UNREIMBURSED MEDICAL EXPENSES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 personal income tax deduction for the amount of unreimbursed medical
- 3 expenses that exceed seven and one-half per cent of a taxpayer's
- 4 adjusted gross income.
