AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR CERTAIN UNREIMBURSED MEDICAL EXPENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
2 personal income tax deduction for the amount of unreimbursed medical
3 expenses that exceed seven and one-half per cent of a taxpayer's
4 adjusted gross income.
