***AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR
UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS AND HUSKY C ASSET LIMITS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to (1) require an undocumented resident to have (A) lived in the state for not less than one year, and (B) applied for legal immigration status to be eligible for medical assistance, and (2) increase HUSKY C asset limits to five thousand dollars for an unmarried individual and seven thousand five hundred dollars for a married couple.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that state medical assistance is targeted to the most vulnerable residents.
