***AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ELECTRONIC PORTAL FOR  
APPLICATIONS FOR STATE GRANT PROGRAMS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 4-68dd of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2026*):

3 (a) [The] Not later than July 1, 2027, the Secretary of the Office of  
4 Policy and Management shall, within available appropriations,  
5 establish and maintain a single electronic portal available on the Internet  
6 and located on the Office of Policy and Management's Internet web site  
7 concerning grants administered or provided by state agencies for the  
8 purpose of posting all state-funded [municipal] grant applications. Such  
9 electronic portal shall be known as the [Municipal] State Grant Portal.

10 (b) The [Municipal] State Grant Portal shall include, but not be  
11 limited to: (1) All state-funded [municipal] grant applications, [and]  
12 municipal reimbursement request forms,] (2) a searchable database for  
13 locating information regarding state-funded [municipal] grants, [and]  
14 (3) an Internet web page dedicated to state-funded municipal grant

15 applications and municipal reimbursement request forms, and (4)  
16 features to encourage the active recruitment and participation of  
17 municipalities and other interested parties in the state-funded  
18 [municipal] grant application process.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
