AN ACT SUPPORTING LOCAL COMMERCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 219 of the general statutes be amended to (1) exempt
2 from the sales and use taxes the sale of electricity and natural gas to
3 commercial and industrial customers with less than ten million dollars
4 in gross income, and (2) dedicate the revenue generated from the
5 additional one per cent of sales tax on meals as follows: (A) Fifty per
6 cent of the amount collected to be deposited in the Tourism Fund; and
7 (B) fifty per cent of the amount collected to be paid to the municipalities

- 8 to which the purchases of the meals are sourced.

Statement of Purpose:

To lower costs for businesses and the costs businesses pass on to consumers.
