PROFESSIONALS SEEKING LICENSURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF

PROFESSIONALS AT TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to eliminate the application fee
- 2 for each health care professional seeking licensure by the Department of
- 3 Public Health and cap the licensure fee for each such professional at two
- 4 hundred dollars.
