"AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE FEDERAL CUTS RESPONSE FUND."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions
4 of subsection (f) of section 4-30a of the general statutes, on the effective
5 date of this act, the Treasurer shall transfer the sum of \$330,811,954 from
6 the Budget Reserve Fund to the General Fund. Such funds shall be used
7 for the purpose set forth in subsection (b) of this section.

8 (b) The Department of Revenue Services shall calculate refunds of the
9 personal income tax under chapter 229 of the general statutes, for such
10 tax actually paid by taxpayers in the state who filed a federal income tax
11 return for the taxable year commencing on or after January 1, 2025, but

12 prior to January 1, 2026. Such refunds shall not exceed \$330,811,954 in
13 the aggregate. The Commissioner of Revenue Services shall submit, in
14 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
15 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
16 cognizance of matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding not later
17 than March 15, 2026, (1) the department's calculations and amounts to
18 be refunded, categorized in such manner as deemed appropriate by the
19 department, and (2) the date and method by which such refunds will be
20 issued."
