"AN ACT CONCERNING RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION WITH RESPECT TO THE CONNECTICUT UNFAIR TRADE PRACTICES ACT AND SPORTS WAGERING."

Strike section 4 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"Sec. 4. Subsection (c) of section 12-861 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(c) The Attorney General, at the request of the commissioner, is authorized to apply in the name of the state to the Superior Court for an order temporarily or permanently restraining and enjoining any person from violating any provision of sections 12-852 to 12-871, inclusive, and from offering, advertising or making available to any resident of this state any sports wagering service without a license required under this chapter and to seek such other or further relief as the court deems appropriate, provided the relief authorized under this subsection does not apply to conduct that would be protected by subdivision (2) of

subsection (a) of section 42-110c. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the commissioner's or the Attorney General's rights and remedies otherwise provided by law."
