1 Strike subsection (d) of section 10 in its entirety and insert the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) Notwithstanding any other law, any peace officer who is found  
4 to have committed an intentional tort of assault, battery, false  
5 imprisonment, false arrest, abuse of process or malicious prosecution,  
6 pursuant to state law or 28 USC 2680(h), while intentionally interfering  
7 with any person taking a photographic or digital still or video image of  
8 such peace officer or another peace officer acting in the performance of  
9 such peace officer's duties, shall not be entitled to assert any privilege or  
10 immunity for their tortious conduct against a claim of civil liability."
