AN ACT REPEALING A CONVEYANCE OF A PARCEL OF STATE LAND TO THE TOWN OF CANTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Special act 24-20 is repealed. (*Effective from passage*)

Explanation

The bill repeals an approved conveyance of a specified parcel of land from the Department of Transportation to the town of Canton. The repeal results in the state retaining use of the asset and precludes a revenue gain up to the fair market value of the property. The town of Canton would forego gaining use of an asset and paying the fair market value and administrative costs of the conveyance.
