Potential Cost

The amendment places additional limitations on who can receive an electronic absentee ballot and results in a potential cost to all municipalities beginning in FY 27. The potential cost is associated with additional printing and postage required to mail absentee ballots. The exact cost will vary by municipality and depend on the number of electors who receive their ballots by mail, who would otherwise have sought ballot delivery via electronic means.
