Cost

The amendment requires that the Secretary of State (SOTS) develop a unique voting identification number that must be printed on the return envelope and absentee ballot application, resulting in a cost to SOTS beginning in FY 27.

The cost to SOTS is associated with the resources and software required to develop such a system. There is an additional potential cost to SOTS to the extent that staff time and resources will be required to implement such a system.
