OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment eliminates the bill's provisions that expand the applicability of automatic absentee ballot application status, reducing the bill's cost to the Secretary of the State (SOTS). The elimination of the bill's expansion of automatic absentee ballot application status reduces SOTS ballot material costs beginning in FY 28 and annually thereafter.
