No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes sections 55 and 56 of the underlying bill, which would hold a construction contractor jointly liable for any unpaid wages owed to a subcontractor's employee under certain construction contracts. This change does not alter the fiscal impact identified in the original fiscal note.
