OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment requires the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to conduct in-home safety evaluations of any individual under the age of 18 who resides with certain individuals on probation or parole, resulting in a potential cost to the agency beginning in FY 27.

DCF may require additional staff and resources to accommodate the visitation schedules required by the amendment. The extent of the potential cost is dependent on: (1) the number of individuals on probation or parole for certain offenses that share a residence with a child; (2) the length of probation or parole for the individuals; and (3) the duration each child resides with such individuals.
