OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment results in a cost, beginning in FY 27, by requiring the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) to apply for licensure as a federally licensed firearms dealer and, upon acquiring such license, facilitate and authorize person-to-person transfers of firearms or ammunition. DESPP does not currently perform this function and it is expected that the agency would incur ongoing costs to implement and perform these duties.
