OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and replaces it with language that results in the same fiscal impact.

In addition, the amendment requires members of fair rent commissions to take a training on mobile manufactured homes under certain circumstances and is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact.

The amendment also removes section 3 of the underlying bill, which increased the maximum relocation expenses owners must pay residents in certain circumstances, and does not result in a fiscal impact.

The amendment makes other technical, clarifying, and conforming changes that do not result in a fiscal impact.
