OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact, resulting in the impact described below.

The amendment requires the Department of Public Health (DPH) to study the feasibility and considerations necessary to implement a Triple Bottom Line Justice (TBLJ) pilot program, resulting in no fiscal impact. DPH has sufficient resources to meet the requirements of the amendment.
