Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment, which establishes a process for certain offenders to apply for a sentence modification, results in a potential savings to the Department of Correction to the extent there is a reduction in incarceration. On average, the marginal cost to the state for incarcerating an offender for the year is \$3,300.¹
