No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to establish a working group to study mercury vapor emissions and other factors associated with crematories used for human remains. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact as DEEP has the staff and expertise necessary to complete the requirements contained within the amendment.
