### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***See Fiscal Note Details***

The amendment caps power purchase agreements at one hundred and fifty percent of the wholesale price at the time of the agreement. The electric distribution companies, which do not own generation, can resell the purchased energy and recover the costs from ratepayers through a reconciling component of their bills (or distribute the profits to ratepayers should the procured energy and related products sell for more than the purchase price). The specific rate payer impact is indeterminate and would be dependent upon the cost of wholesale price, how the cap affects solicitations, and terms of the power purchase agreements. The amendment does not result in a cost to the state or municipalities.
