Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment creates an infraction for smoking any cannabis or cannabis product, or use any electronic cannabis delivery system or vapor product containing cannabis, in any location within a public area that is within twenty-five feet of any individual who is younger than eighteen years of age, resulting in a potential revenue gain from fines.
