No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact.

The amendment, which prohibits revisions to the State Building Code, the State Fire Prevention Code, and the Fire Safety Code until the publication of the national model codes in 2030, results in no fiscal impact. The amendment, which also requires the Department of Administrative Services to submit a report related to the effects of extending the cycle of revisions for these codes, results in no fiscal impact.
